

MODEL BASED QUANTITATIVE PRECIPITATION FORECAST



OPERATIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF ARPS MODEL



Advance Regional Prediction System (ARPS) Model for North East Monsoon is run using Initial and boundary condition from IMD Global Forecasting System (GFS). The radial velocity and reflectivity data of DWR are assimilated in ARPS Model through ADAS data assimilation package. The assimilation is performed as a sequence of intermittent cycles of 20 minutes. Reflectivity (dBZ) overlaid on wind field (knots) at 850 hPa, is plotted for next 3 hours updated at every hour round the clock. Real time forecast from ARPS Model with Radar Data assimilation are available on http://www.imd.gov.in/section/nhac/dynamic/ARPS NE MON.htm.
